Hello, Product Lover!

The edition of our barometer that you're about to explore is undoubtedly one of the most significant since we launched this initiative in 2019. Positive in terms of participation: 353 professionals. This is quite substantial for professions in Digital Product, which were barely known in Spain just five years ago, despite their importance, and are still relatively unknown outside the "tech" realm.

We want to express our sincerest gratitude to all of you for dedicating your time to share this valuable information.

From its inception, Product has always aimed to have an economic impact, not just to create value for its users. The rise of roles like Product Marketing or Product Ops that is happening in the English-speaking world or, closer to home, in France, is an encouraging sign of this understanding: the business in Product goes beyond delivering functionalities. And that surge will eventually reach Spain.

However, as with any sudden change, this transition comes with side effects. Some are evident, such as tighter budgets, redundancies, and a rebalancing between supply and demand that affects salary progression. Others are less apparent, such as the impact on our mental health.

That's why we've decided to **partner with moka.care**, whose goal is to help companies create healthier work environments. We want to highlight issues that are still challenging for us to address, both individually and collectively. Often, it's difficult to confide in our colleagues, the HR department, or managers. The topic remains taboo in the workplace.

In the barometer, it's observed that over 60% of respondents consider that mental health issues sometimes affect their productivity. Work intensity and workload are by far the main psychosocial risk factors affecting the Product Community. We want to emphasize this fact: 39.5% of Product professionals report that work intensity and workload affect their mental health. The good news is that the majority of professionals rate their passion for their profession between 8 and 9 out of 10.

The rest of the study follows the trend of the previous year. We've delved into many aspects of the roles of Product Managers, Product Designers, and Product Leaders. In the latter segment, we must exercise caution when interpreting the results, as the sample size has been small, affecting the representativeness of the data. In the rest of the study, you'll also find information on organizations, activities, salaries, and gender equality.

We continue to monitor the gender pay gap, which we consider crucial given the extent of inequality in the Product field, both in terms of numbers and salaries.

Finally, we've adjusted the parameter of years of experience in Product to align with the methods used to calculate market salary surveys. We now count the total number of years of professional experience.








What remote work policy has your company adopted? (per week)


















What is the size of your company?











How many years of professional experience do you have?

What is your favorite and least favorite thing about your job?








On a scale of 0 to 10, how do you feel?







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On a scale of 0 to 10, do you like your job?








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Does a mental health issue sometimes impact your productivity?

75.4% of respondents said that a mental health problem sometimes affected their productivity, in moka.care's Product&Santé Mentale survey conducted in February 2023.


What psychosocial risk factors do you consider to be most prevalent in your company's product teams?




How many people do you manage?




How do you rate the recruitment of **Product profiles?**




What are the direct responsibilities of a Product Manager in your company?





What are the direct responsibilities of a Product Designer in your company?




What is the Design organization?


What is the ratio of designers to product teams?

How well does the rest of your company understand the roles of **Product Managers, Product Designers, and Product Marketing Managers?**








Who do the PMs/POs report to?





Who does the Product Design team report to?












Your salary



What is your total gross annual package in k€? You count fixed + bonus + variable.





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
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




